Dear Neighbor:

Throughout the years, I have fielded numerous complaints about the toll on the Henry Hudson Bridge, and the frustration is understandable. Many find it perplexing that such a short bridge requires a toll, especially when recalling the days when it was merely a dime.

Securing a rebate for the Henry Hudson Bridge Toll has been a primary focus of mine, advocating for it in budget negotiations, particularly in the broader context of mass transit funding. Despite delays due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the implementation is now imminent.

Here is the breakdown: Bronx residents with a car registered in the borough and a funded EZ-Pass will receive an instant rebate on the Henry Hudson Bridge toll. Once this takes effect in February 2024, you will be charged the toll and immediately credited the same amount whenever you cross the bridge. I vigorously pushed for this measure, recognizing the undue burden tolls impose on Bronx residents using this short bridge. I thank Governor Kathy Hochul and the MTA for supporting this commendable initiative.
