Alternate Side Parking (ASP) or street cleaning rules: Most Alternate Side Parking signs are clearly marked with the "P" symbol with the broom through it. Some signs are the traditional 3-hour ones, but others can vary considerably. Some metered parking zones have Alternate Side Parking rules.

Alternate Side Parking regulations may be suspended from time to time because of snow, inclement weather or other emergencies. Visit nyc.gov/dot or dial 311 for further information. TTY deaf or hearing-impaired, dial 212-504-4115.

When Alternate Side Parking is suspended for a holiday or other reason, the parking meters remain in effect.

***Major Legal Holiday rules:** The city suspends ASP rules on the legal and religious holidays listed in this brochure. No Stopping, No Standing and No Parking regulations are also suspended, except where those regulations are normally in effect seven days a week (for example, "No Standing Anytime"). Parking meter regulations are also suspended. On all other holidays, only street cleaning rules are suspended.

Dear Friends,

It's hard to believe my first term is coming to a close! Since taking office over two years ago, I have passed numerous pieces of legislation. There are two that will especially have a major impact on this borough and the State of New York.

As I'm sure you know, our gun violence epidemic has ravaged communities across the country and right here at home. Since public safety is a top issue of mine and many of my constituents, we passed a package of gun safety bills designed to keep New Yorkers safe. My bill, which expanded the definition of a firearm, was among this package. It was signed into law in early June.

Secondly, after the deadly fire at the Twin Parks Apartment last January, it was determined that the cause was a faulty space heater. Almost immediately after, I introduced a bill that would place restrictions on electric space heaters. It later passed unanimously in both chambers and has been signed into law. Electric space heaters sold in New York will now require a thermostat and an automatic shutoff. More importantly, it will protect people in their homes during the cold winter months.

In addition to legislative accomplishments, my team has provided a significant amount of constituent services on a daily basis. Over the past two years, we have successfully helped thousands of constituents secure unemployment benefits and receive health insurance at low or no cost. We even made sure that those struggling with rent or mortgage payments can stay in their homes.

It's needless to say that our work doesn't get done without my amazing staff. Every day, I am so lucky and grateful for their dedication to the 85th Assembly District. I cannot thank them enough for their service to our community.

And finally, to you, my incredible constituents. Not only have you placed your trust in me, you have shown your commitment to make our community a better place. Whether it's stopping by my office or community events, or even approaching me in a grocery store, your passion only inspires me to work harder to best serve you.

Again, thank you! I wish you and your loved ones a very Happy Holiday and New Year. Let's continue our great work in 2023 and beyond!

¡Es difícil creer que mi primer término en el cargo está llegando a su fin! Desde que asumí esta posición hace más de dos años, he aprobado numerosas piezas de legislación. Existen dos que tendrán un impacto importante en este condado y en el estado de Nueva York especialmente.

Estoy seguro de que ustedes saben que nuestra epidemia de violencia armada ha devastado a comunidades en todo el país y aquí mismo, en nuestra comunidad. Debido a que la seguridad pública es una prioridad para mí y para muchos de mis constituyentes, aprobamos un paquete de proyectos de ley sobre la seguridad de las armas de fuego diseñado para mantener a los neoyorquinos seguros. Mi proyecto de ley, que amplía el significado de un arma de fuego, fue incluido en este paquete y firmado en ley a principios de junio.

Segundo, tras el mortal incendio en los Apartamentos Twin Parks el pasado mes de enero, se determinó que la causa fue un calentador portátil defectuoso. Casi inmediatamente después, presenté un proyecto de ley que establecería restricciones sobre el uso de los calentadores portátiles eléctricos. Luego, se aprobó unanimemente en ambas Cámaras y ha sido firmado en ley. Ahora, los calentadores portátiles eléctricos vendidos en Nueva York requerirán un termostato y apagado automático. Principalmente, esta legislación protegerá a las personas en sus hogares durante los fríos meses de invierno.

Además de los logros legislativos, mi equipo ha provisto una cantidad significativa de servicios a los constituyentes diariamente. Durante los últimos dos años, hemos ayudado exitosamente a miles de constituyentes a asegurar beneficios de desempleo y a recibir seguro de salud a bajo o a ningún costo. Incluso, nos aseguramos de que aquellas personas que enfrentan dificultades con el pago del alquiler o de la hipoteca puedan permanecer en sus hogares.

No hace falta mencionar que nuestra labor no podría ser posible sin nuestro maravilloso equipo. Todos los días, me siento tan afortunado y agradecido por su dedicación al Distrito 85 de la Asamblea. No puedo agradecerles lo suficiente por su servicio a nuestra comunidad.


